## Florist and Decorations

- 1. All decorations should be in place prior to taking pre-service photographs (if applicable).
- 2. Webster Gardens does not provide candelabras but does have a Unity Candle stand for use in our Sanctuary.
- 3. Webster Gardens does not provide or encourage use of a runner for the center aisle because it is a tripping hazard.
- 4. Petals from real flowers petals are not allowed to be dropped down the center aisle because they can stain the carpet. If fake petals are to be used, it is the responsibility of the wedding party to collect and dispose of these after the wedding. Church vacuums cannot be used to collect these due to the possibility of damaging the equipment.
- 5. Each section of the Sanctuary has 13 rows of pews. Nothing may be taped, nailed or glued to the pews or any other furniture.
- 6. The throwing of rice, confetti, bird seed, etc is not permitted in the church or anywhere on church grounds. If you wish to be showered with something as you leave, we suggest bubbles outside the building.
- 7. Please remember the sanctuary is the place of worship for this congregation and we ask that:
  - No food or drink be brought into the sanctuary.
  - No church "furniture" or items placed on the altar be moved or removed.
  - Flowers be placed only on the flower stands in the chancel. (Flowers may not be placed on the altar.)
  - Paraments and altar cloths may not be obscured or changed to coordinate with your wedding. (These reflect the color of the church season.)
- 8. Once a florist is selected, arrange delivery times according to when you scheduled the wedding site coordinator to be at Webster Gardens. Someone needs to be at the church to accept the delivery. Be sure to discuss this with the site coordinator as well scheduling removal of flowers and decorations after the wedding. (These details should be discussed prior to the rehearsal.)
