Photography

- 1. The photographer may take pictures before and after the service in any part of the building except offices and classrooms.
- 2. It is a good idea to provide the photographer with a list of pictures you want taken on the wedding day. This should be given to the photographer prior to minimize the amount of time spent gathering people for pictures. Please make the wedding site coordinator aware if you would like pictures taken with the pastor prior or following the ceremony.
- 3. Flash pictures are NOT allowed during the wedding ceremony except during the processional and recessional.
- 4. If a videographer will be present, Webster Gardens recommends this person make prior arrangements to meet with a technician from Webster Gardens at least two weeks before the wedding to discuss any special sound/tech issues that may need coordinating. This should be arranged through the site coordinator. During the ceremony, no photographs or taping may be done from the chancel area. Any moving around distracts from your marriage service.
